AIDS Education and Prevention—An Interdisciplinary Journal intends to publish a special issue on the topic of “Corrections: At the Crossroads of the Opioid Epidemic and HIV/HCV/STI Experiences” in **February 2020**. We are seeking scientific articles including original research, systematic reviews, and commentaries.

The special issue is interested in publishing manuscripts on the following topics or any similar topics with relevance to HIV:

- The syndemics of opioid use and HIV
- HCV and/or STIs among correctional populations as a signal for HIV vulnerability
- Common drivers behind HCV, STI, and HIV among justice involved populations
- How the opioid epidemic is changing the landscape of HIV and HCV in the correctional setting and among vulnerable populations
- Prevention and management of HIV among persons under judicial supervision
- Incarceration as a factor contributing to the persistence of the HIV epidemic in the US (or hastening its elimination)
- Novel interventions in correctional settings to reduce HIV, HCV, STI and long-term substance use
- The role of syringe service programs, health departments, and other community-based entities as a partner in the prevention and management of those with correctional and substance use experiences and vulnerable to or living with HIV, HCV, and STIs
