

New IP Authentication Process for Institutional Journal Subscribers

June 10, 2026 – Guilford Press is pleased to announce that we have partnered with theIPregistry.org to make the process of checking, monitoring, and updating the IP addresses used to authenticate access to Journals content easier for institutional subscribers.

Starting June 22, 2026, Guilford will use theIPregistry.org data to authenticate access to Journals content. This service allows our institutional customers to manage your IP addresses in one place and broadcast changes to multiple publishers, including Guilford Press, from a secure, central location. The registry is provided free for our subscribers.

If you have not already done so, the first step is:

- Please register at theIPregistry.org and confirm the IPs currently registered to your institution.
- Once you have created your account you can communicate any IP address updates by simply logging in to your account and adding (or deleting) the relevant IP address(es).

In future we ask you to report all IP changes to Guilford Press via theIPregistry.org.
